







Do the school values help you to understand how to live together as a school




'It is good to have courage and try new things'

Does your teacher help you when you find things hard?




'I have supportive teachers and friends'

My teacher(s) knows me and understands how I learn






What are you proud of achieving in class / school this year?

'I'm proud of getting a Head Teacher Award'


'I'm proud of swimming 50 metres'



Do you have supportive classmates?




Given a chance, what is the one change that you would like to see in your school or class?

'I'd like an upstairs for our school'




I know how to keep myself safe online

Do you think that the school provides you with enough sports / musical opportunities?




Your school is part of a family of schools. What sort of things would you like to be able to do with other schools in our Trust?
